

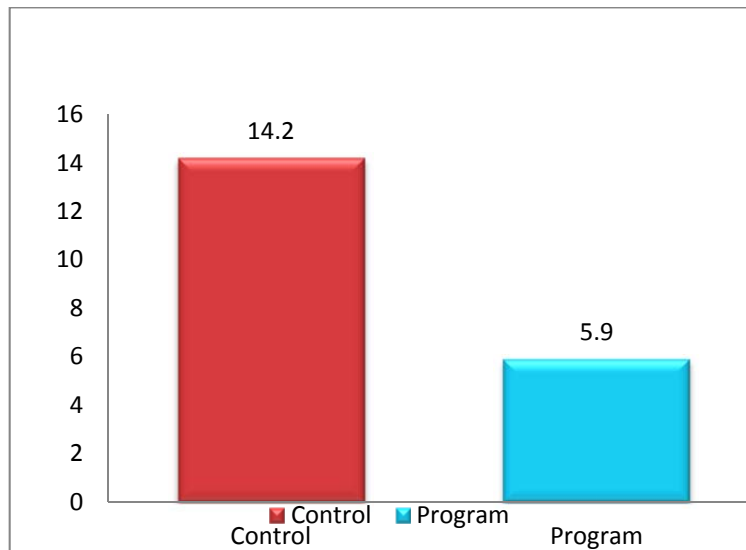


Does It Work?

AEGIS Research - Student Data

Research from a five-year study that included 3,000 students, 200 teachers and 2,000 parents showed extraordinary results in improving student behavior. When problems did occur among children, they were less serious and more likely to be resolved among themselves.

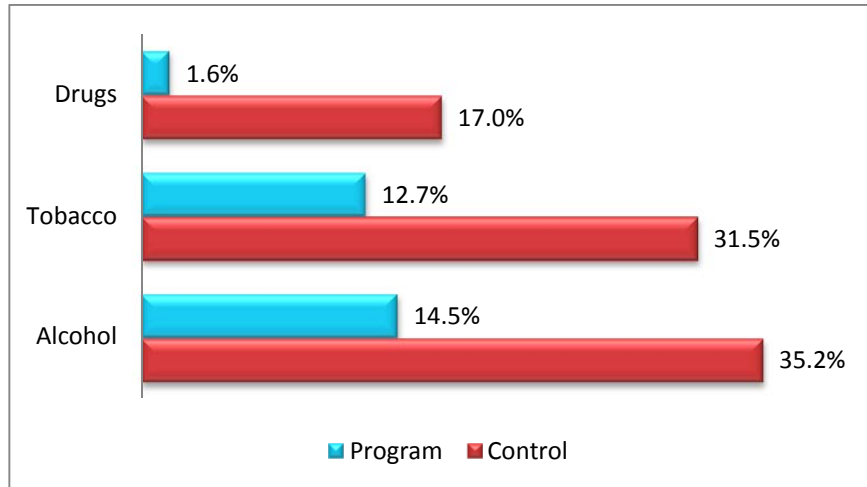
Data showed a 250 percent lower level of problem behavior in the classroom. Teasing and bullying were significantly reduced. Citizenship scores increased appreciably. There was more time to spend on academic tasks. Comparison between program and non-program students also showed an increase in respect and care of school properties.



Discipline and Behavior Problems

Number of instances per day

Experimentation with drugs, tobacco, and alcohol was 140% lower in the program group (with three years of character education in elementary school) as compared to the control group - even though these subjects are not directly addressed in the curriculum.
